

## A DESSERT ROLL PROJECT FEATURING:

## GREENSTONE Wivili

## MOVING THE LINE QUILT

Finished Size: $64^{\prime \prime} \times 68^{\prime \prime}$

## CUTTING

GREENSTONE DESSERT ROLL:
Each $5^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip in your Dessert Roll will yield (3) 5 " $\times 131 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. To achieve the look of 'moving lines' in each block, make sure to cut the first rectangle from the very center of the strip, with the line separating two prints at the $63 / 4$ " mark on your ruler. If you have any pinked edges overhanging beyond 5 ", trim those as well to help with more precise piecing later.


Cut a 5 " $\times 131 / 2$ " rectangle, with the center aligned with the center 'line' of the strip.

After cutting the center rectangle, trim both of the remaining ends of the strip to $5^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat for all (12) strips in the Dessert Roll.


You need (36) 5" x 1312" rectangles total.

Trim remaining pieces to $5^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Line placement not as important as the initial center cut.

## BORDER FABRICS:

From each of (4) $3 / 4$ Yard Border Fabrics, cut (11) $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ Width of Fabric strips.
From the first (9) strips, cut (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 13 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle from each.
From the remaining (2) strips, cut (9) 2 " $\times 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
You will have (18) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 13^{1 / 2 "}$ and (18) 2 " $\times 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for each of the border fabrics.


## BINDING:

Cut (7) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips and set aside for binding.

## BEFORE YOU START MAKING THE BLOCKS:

We recommend laying out the quilt to decide placement of the Dessert Roll prints and borders, to make sure you're happy with the arrangement before committing to fabric pairings. Make sure to pick darker borders for the 'low volume' Dessert Roll pieces, for good contrast!

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## PIECING

Use a scant $1 / 4$ " seam allowance throughout. Press seams as noted.
To make the blocks, attach matching 2" x 131/2" Border pieces to the top and bottom of each Dessert Roll rectangle. Press seams open.
Then, attach matching 2 " x 8 " Border pieces to either side of the block. Press seams open. Make (36) $8^{\prime \prime} \times 16 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Blocks.


Each border fabric will go into (9) blocks, for (36) Total $8^{\prime \prime} \times 16 \frac{1}{2}$ " Blocks.
For the Binding, join (7) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips together end to end on the bias, making one long strip. Trim the seams allowances to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, and press open. Then, press strip in half Wrong Sides Together to make one long folded strip.
Set aside to attach after quilting, and then finish in your preferred method.

## ASSEMBLY

If you didn't already, lay out your quilt top into 9 rows of 4 blocks each. Make sure you're happy with which borders are next to each other, and also the distribution of colors and 'moving line' placements. Or, follow the quilt top layout here. Join blocks into 9 rows, pressing seams open, or in alternating directions for each row, shown by the arrows, so that the seams nest when joined together.
Join the rows together, pressing seams open.
Baste, Quilt, Bind, and Enjoy!
